A retrospective, post-marketing study



158 patients were enrolled from April 2011 to October 2012 at a single centre in India



Clinical follow-up at 1-year and 3-year



Clinical outcomes for performance and survivorship were analyzed




Figure 1: American Knee society Score




Figure 2: Range of motion

> WOMAC pain score




Figure 3: WOMAC pain score

> WOMAC stiffness score




Figure 4: WOMAC stiffness score
